




2018 V. 2019 PARTICIPATION RESULTS: GENDER

















### 2019 RESULTS HIGHLIGHTS: CONVERSATION TOPICS






### 2019 RESULTS HIGHLIGHTS: MOST IMPORTANT COMMUNITY ISSUES

During On the Table discussions in 2019, 90% of participants said they are very or somewhat likely to take specific action as a result of their conversation.




In 2019, youth participants were able to complete an abbreviated version of the On the Table survey.


### 2019 RESULTS HIGHLIGHTS YOUTH SURVEY: GENDER






### 2019 RESULTS HIGHLIGHTS YOUTH SURVEY: AGE







### NEXT STEPS

In March 2020, Akron Community Foundation will award up to \$100,000 in On the Table Community Impact Award grants to local nonprofits that develop projects to address actionable ideas that came out of their conversations.

#### **NEXT STEPS**

On the Table data also has continued to inform Akron Community Foundation's proactive grantmaking strategy, of which more than \$200,000 has so far been invested, to address Diversity, Equity & Social Inclusion and Our Aging Seniors. Proactive grantmaking will continue in 2020.

#### **NEXT STEPS**
